There are also volumes of sketches of London and letters and newspaper cuttings, the subjects of which include the history of London, criminology and The Gentlemen's Magazine.

Translation:

"Head quarters of the Supreme Commander in Chief. Office of the Quartermaster General. 25th June 1917.

Authorisation.

This is to inform you that British Army Captain Bromhead is permitted to visit the troops and headquarters and also the families of the troops in army institutions of the northern, western, south-western and Rumanian fronts in order to demonstrate on film the last offensive of the English army on the French fronts [literally in the French theatres].

With Captain Bromhead are two mechanics, Greengrass and Pratt.

Concerning the site for the organisation of film makers' representatives, Captain Bromhead has undertaken to obtain instructions in the headquarters of the front. They will be here for the period 25th June until 1st October 1917."
